Proposed DONG Energy offshore wind farm – Westermost Rough: 8km off the coast of the East Riding of Yorkshire

DONG Energy is proposing to build a wind farm 8 kilometres (km) offshore, in the area between the Humber Estuary and Flamborough Head. The project would be a significant local source of renewable energy, with a generating capacity of 180-240 megawatts (MW) – equivalent to the average annual electricity needs of approximately 150,000 households.

Prior to a planning application being submitted for development of the site, we would like to invite members of the local community to look at, and feedback on, the proposals. We feel it is important for people to have the plans explained to them directly rather than through a third party.
